Brief

To develop a multi-platform approach to support national teacher training programming.

Solution

The concept for the multi-platform series Lesson on Plate was originated by In Cahoots. It is designed to give hard-pressed teachers literally all the resources they need to try out a lesson for themselves.

Lessons developed include:

- Poetry Alive
- Murder Mystery Maths
- Pitching the Past
- Algebra - Equations in Reverse

The lesson ideas come from and are authored on screen by teachers themselves. Each one has a specially shot video sequence to motivate students from the start, and a demonstration lesson presented by the teachers themselves. Before the series aired a blog was established around sneak previews of the material. When the series went live online and was then broadcast the audience were able to join in an existing conversation. As each fifteen minute programme plays online 'hanging bats' on the timeline prompt break-outs to other video windows illustrating the resources being used. These are all downloadable.
